Exclusion Criteria is noted below if you could update that click link:

Referral Exclusion Criteria:

- For patients with an age of 75 or older, please fax the referral to a hospital based Endoscopist as the patient is not suitable for Gastroscopy/Colonoscopy at our Out-of-Hospital facility.
- If multiple comorbidities, the patient may not be suitable for Gastroscopy/Colonoscopy at our Out-of-Hospital facility. The referral triaging Physician will review and notify your office.
- Patient's BMI of 40 or over, please fax the referral to a hospital based Endoscopist as the patient is not suitable for Gastroscopy/Colonoscopy at our Out-of-Hospital facility.

*****Patient's with BMI of 36 – 39.9 will be triaged by the referral triaging Physician; the patient may be requested to have Anesthesia consult prior to scheduling an Endoscopy procedure to determine whether the patient is suitable for procedure at London Scoping Centre.*****

- Patients who require lift/transfer equipment are best suited to be seen in a hospital setting as our facility does not have this equipment.
- Patient with/suspected to have Esophageal Varices are best suited to be seen in a hospital setting.
- Patient's with hemoglobin of 80 or less are best suited to be seen in a hospital setting.
